## LEAGUE RULES

- League is open to all shooters, club members and non-members; adults and youth. If enough interested youth wish to participate, a separate youth league for awards can be established if there are enough youth participants (5 or more).
- We need a minimum of 5 shooters to make this league happen, however it would be preferred to have at least 10, 15, or more shooters participating. <u>More is better</u>!
- League is <u>SINGLES TRAP</u> only. Each week shoot 50 targets at 16 yd. (i.e. 2 rounds of 25).
- League shooting will be available Sundays from 9:00am to 12:00pm (more or less); except for severe weather, etc. <u>No League on October 13 as there is an ATA Shoot.</u>
- League will be shot as individual scores, with 400 total targets. <u>They can be ATA registered as a BIG 50</u>, but they don't have to be. Registering your targets must be declared prior to shooting and you must pay the reduced BIG 50 ATA & MTA fees (see below). Must have minimum of 3 shooters for ATA registration for each shoot date.
- League Fee is \$20.00 per shooter for the Final League Winners pot of money.
- League Weekly Shooting Fees: \$10.00 (covers both rounds). Youth ≤ 18 is \$8.00
- <u>BIG 50 Fees\*</u>: ATA \$2.00, MTA \$1.50, MTA Target Assessment fee \$1.00/50 targets each week. \**Fees only apply to shooters who wish to have their scores registered with ATA.*
- League shooting should be made up on the next league shoot date that you are present. Tuesday evenings are also allowed for make-ups. A maximum of 2 weeks may be made up on any single day. (Note: *make-ups can't be registered*). All week's scores will count for this Fall League; no scores will be dropped. NO LEAGUE ON OCT 13 (ATA SHOOT).
- League Targets must be shot in increments of 50 (two rounds of 25 per week) and declared at the time of shooting. Practice rounds may still be shot at normal club fees.
- Shot size for this league is 8 or 7½. No heavy 6 shot or larger size for league shooting! Shotguns in gauges 28 through 12, plus 410 are acceptable, however there will be no allowances or distinction made between shotgun gauge categories. (A separate 410 only league can be run in enough interest. See shoot management.)
- Scores and Current Standings will be posted at the club house, if possible.
- Final League Winnings will be by Lewis Class and issued after completion of League.
- Lewis ties will first be broken by the largest number of 25's, 24's, 23's, etc, per shooter. If still tied after this method, ties will be broken by shoot-off or other method (coin toss, reverse long run, arm wrestle, etc.).
- The number of Lewis Classes for Final League Winners will be determined after the total number of shooters is set, and will be based on approximately 5 shooters per class (or similar equal divisions), paying 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places (50%, 30%, 20% split) per class.
- The money available for the Lewis Classes will be divided equally among the classes.
- Class division will be based strictly on Lewis System Rules.
