This August the Club piloted a modified Summer Shotgun Ironman competition. This event was spearheaded by our 5-Stand / Skeet coordinator Joel Weeks. The event had participants shoot 1 round each of 16 -yard (singles) trap, 23-yard handicap trap, skeet, and 5-Stand. We had 7

competitors, including our first lady shooter! Our winner was Mel Yoder (left), hitting 84 of 100 targets. Our youth winner was Caleb Reinbold (right), who hit a close 82/100. We may try this again next June.

Fall Trap League and ATA BIG 50's

On Sundays starting Sept 22 through Nov 17 (minus the Oct 13 ATA, Trap shoot), will be the 2024 Fall Trap League with concurrent (and optional) ATA registered BIG 50 Trap Shoots. This is a 16-yard Singles money league with the "option" to register your targets in any given league week. This BIG 50 option must be stated prior to shooting that week's scores. Standard weekly target fees plus the league fee of \$20.

Open to club members and non-members, and as always, youth can also partake in either activity. The League starts at 9am each slated Sunday and runs to about noon. Tuesday evening make ups are allowed.

Other BIG 50 events, such as handicap and or doubles, may be added providing we have at least 3 shooters for each additional event. Not a current ATA Member? No problem, you can join the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) at this or any other ATA event. Adults \$20 for the full ATA target year, youth under 18 are \$12. See ya at the range!
