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December Member Meeting

Winter Trap & Skeet Leagues Jan 5 - Mar 9

This year's annual **Winter Trap and Skeet Leagues** will run from 1/5/25 to 3/9/25. Trap is planned to be a 10-week money league with 8 of the weeks scores to count, *unless the participants collectively choose less due to weather, etc.* Each week will be 50 targets (2 rounds). Shoot can be modified if agreed upon by participants. The cost is \$20 for the trap league fee for the pot of money, plus each week's regular shoot fees (for targets). The top spot of this year's Fall Trap League was Larry York, who hit 383 out of 400 total targets for a score of 95.8%. Our Runner Up was Jeff Bailey, a VERY close second, with 95.5% (382/400). Larry and Jeff were neck-in-neck for the top spot throughout this fall league with Larry taking top spot by 1 target. Jeff hit the only 50/50 during the weekly league scoring. Our Third Place winner was Leslie York with a score of 92.3% (369/400). There was only one Lewis Class as there were not enough competitors this fall to warrant a second class. Important Michigan Legislative News: Gun-Free Zones

Michigan Senate Bill 858 along with a few other related Senate and House bills is modifying some <u>gun-free zones</u>. Currently under the Michigan Penal Code, laws are in place that prohibit Michigan (and other state) residents from possessing a firearm on the premises of any of the following (*with some exemptions for CPL holders*):

- -- A depository financial institution or a subsidiary or affiliate of such an institution.
- -- A church or other house of religious worship.
- -- A court.
- -- A theatre.
- -- A sports arena.
- -- A day care center.
- -- A hospital.
- -- An establishment licensed under the Michigan Liquor Control Code.

A violation is a misdemeanor punishable by up to 90 days' imprisonment or a maximum fine of \$100, or both.

<u>Proposed changes to the existing law originally included the following:</u>

- 1. Under the new "revised" bills, the provisions above would now also include the premises of the <u>Michigan State Capitol Building</u>, the <u>Anderson House Office Building</u>, or the <u>Binsfeld Senate Office Building</u>. The bill would exempt from its provisions an acting member of the Michigan House of Representatives or the Michigan Senate who has a CPL, but not other CPL's.
- 2. Additionally, the existing "law" exempts licensed CPL holders to carry a concealed weapon from some of the provisions described above. Most notably the liquor license to sell in places that didn't include consuming the beverages on premises (i.e. grocery stores, gas stations) THE PROPOSED BILL WOULD HAVE DELETED THIS EXEMPTION!

The new Senate Bill SB 858 originally proposed expansion of gun free zones even for those who are licensed to carry concealed. The largest change would have banned carry in "any location" with a liquor license, which includes any business that not only serves liquor but offers it for sale. This sweeping expansion would have prohibited carrying in many commonly frequented business establishments including gas stations, pharmacies, hotels, restaurants, grocery stores, big box retailers, and many other locations throughout the state. This expansion was not rooted in public safety, but in further eroding the rights of law-abiding Michiganders. Thankfully this section has been clarified and restored the exemption for CPL holders, this time!

Elections have consequences. This is a reminder that we must all stay vigilant and keep on top of proposed changes to the firearm laws of Michigan, as well as at the Federal level, to preserve our Second Amendment rights!

REMEMBER: EYE AND EAR PROTECTION IS REQUIRED ON ALL RANGES

ALSO: THE FRONT GATE IS TO BE LOCKED BEHIND YOU WHEN ENTERING OR LEAVING, EXCEPT FOR ORGANIZED ACTIVITY TIMES
